Minutes of August 7, 2018 Regular Meeting

- Hudson Energy informed Township that rate will decrease with next billing.

Recognition of Guests/For the Good of the Township:

- Resident Blakeney questioned if Township could request help from State removing trees and debris from streams. J. Kline explained DEP and Conservation District regulations involving streams.
