- The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman J. Kline.
- November meeting minutes reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried
- The financials were reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

Road Foreman:

- Church & Clover each had 300 ton of stone pit down. Mow. Trim & remove trees. Truck maintenance. Cinder both Sunday & Monday. Several road signs missing. Will check prices before ordering.
- 1998 truck blew head gasket and ruined engine. Must be rebuilt which will be too costly. Inspected a 2006 Peterbilt truck in Tobyhanna. Very good condition. Truck being auctioned on Municibid. Will check with Bradco and other suppliers to see if they have anything comparable. Motion to bid on truck at the discretion of the Supervisors up to \$50,000 made by J. Kline, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

- FEMA informed Sugarloaf Twp that PEMA must handle disasters in PA in the future. FEMA will only be involved in national incidents.
