Fishing Creek Flood Plain Administrator Report - 2/5/19

1. Rosie Johnston -14D Winding Road. Request to elevate. Mrs. Johnston has contacted DEP and is in the process of completing the required paperwork to request inspection by DEP.
2. Weston Brehm - Deputy Director Columbia County Redevelopment Authority - 35 Crickside Lane. Request to build new structure and elevate. Due to ongoing discussion regarding the status of the waterway which is adjacent to the property, a site inspection by DEP has been requested. Am awaiting a status update on this project.
3. John Lapp contacted me recently. He has three properties in Fishing Creek Township which he is contracted to raise. He told me that all three properties were within 50' of the bank of Fishing Creek and he is seeking approval from DEP.

Once DEP has inspected the above properties and given their approval, we will move forward with issuing Pre-Construction Permits.

I have also completed the 2018 Floodplain Management Activities Annual Report form and submitted it to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency.
