Minutes of January 3, 2017 Regular Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 6:20 PM by Chairman J. Challingsworth.
- The December meeting minutes reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Kline. Motion carried.
- The financials were reviewed. Additional invoice to Central Site Services for \$860 approved. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

Reports:

Road Foreman:

- Crew continues to plow, cinder, mow; clean ditches and pipes, put down stone on Keller and O'Brien Roads. All road signs have been replaced except Keller Road.
- CCCD representative Corbin completing final inspection of Martenas Road on Wednesday.
- J. Challingsworth made motion, seconded by E. Bogert to authorize Kocher Tree Service to proceed with tree trimming on Mountain Road and possibly Tioga Pike. Motion carried. Kocher fees have increased \$10 to \$150 per hour.
- Due to cost of new power washer, Township will attempt to repair old power washer. Switch will be ordered for repair.
