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Minutes of July 7, 2015 Regular Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman J. Challingsworth.

The June meeting minutes reviewed. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

The financials were reviewed. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

Reports:

Road Foreman:

- Tar and chip completed despite the weather. 29,000 gallons oil and 1000 ton of stone used.
- Mowing roads; clean up storm damage. Still some ditches need to be cleaned.
- Contact B. Travelpiece for suggestions to improve Kinney Hill Road.

Old Business:

New Business:

- Ordinance 02-15 to join the PSATS Employee Health Group. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.
- 3 quotes to replace 54" pipe on Kramer Hill Road, tabled from last meeting. Sokol \$13,920; Yost \$10,666; Hile Enterprises \$10,604. Motion by E. Bogert to accept Hile quote, seconded by J. Challingsworth. J. Kline abstained from the vote. Township will supply the pipe, and contact Hile to schedule work.
- Advertise for new members to join the Agricultural Security Area program. Changes to existing parcels will be reviewed in 2017. Interested residents can contact the Township for more information.

Correspondence:

- The Township wishes to secure a grant for the reflectivity meter required to comply with

improved signage on Township roads. Senator Gordner sent a letter to the State supporting the grant.

Recognition of Guests:

- Resident Catherine Wagner, 25 Oak Road, complained that a neighbor at 26 Oak Road, installed a driveway that infringes on her property, preventing her from mowing part of her lawn. J. Challingsworth has issued no permit for a driveway. Challingsworth instructed her to obtain a copy of the survey map. He will speak with the resident.
- W. Blakeney questioned if all contractors working for Township are bonded. J. Challingsworth stated they are bonded. He asked what the initials CCTOA stood for (Columbia County Township Officials Association); asked the price of cinders from McClure (\$19.50 a CY); asked if tar and chip was completed. There were some areas with cracks, etc. J. Kline explained they will use the dura-patcher to take care of those areas.
- A. Stackhouse reported an exposed pipe Church Road. Road crew will repair.
- R. Wenner reported the ditch near his home needs to be cleaned. Surface water running into his field. He also asked that road crew mow bank by light pole.
