# Officials repeat, recycling rules

Fishing Creek Township officials remind residents to recycle only those items that are accepted at the township recycling center.

There has been an ongoing problem with people dropping off unacceptable items such as plastic waste cans, gasoline cans, bins and laundry baskets; toys and household garbage.

If an item is not listed on the signs at the center it should not be dropped off, officials say.

The township will upgrade to single-stream recycling on Oct. 1. That means acceptable items will be placed into the same container.

There will be a separate bin for cardboard.

No items may be left on the ground around the bins.

The center serves residents of Fishing Creek, Benton and Sugarloaf townships, plus Stillwater. It is not open to the general public.
