Minutes of July 6, 2021 Regular Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 6 pm by Chairman J. Kline. Present were: J. Beishline; J. Kline; S. Masich and Secretary Kindt and 10 attendees.
- June meeting minutes reviewed. S. Masich made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.
- Financials reviewed. Addition payments to Yost for hauling \$2970.85 and \$700 to Central Sites Services for sewage inspections. J. Beishline made motion to approve, seconded by S. Masich. Motion carried.

Reports:

Road Foreman:- Getting trucks ready for tar & chip. Townships working together on tar & chip: Jackson; Benton; North Centre; Sugarloaf and Fishing Creek. Chipper will need repair. Mowing berms.

Old Business:

- Residents questioned zoning for solar farms. With no zoning in Fishing Creek Twp, solar farms are allowed.
- Jennifer Wakeman from DRIVE reported the cell tower on Oak Road went online Thursday. Provides service as far as outskirts of Millville.

New Business:

- Application has been submitted to DCED for ARPA grant. This grant is a stimulus payment for monies lost between 2019 and 2020 due to the pandemic. Monies can only be used for a very small list of items. PSATS is working to have the uses for this money expanded.
- A EDCDI grant for stream work at the Young and Rees properties has been submitted to County.

Correspondence:

- Request from Volunteers in Medicine of Mifflinville was denied.

Recognition of Guests/For the Good of the Township:

- Resident Fisher questioned if Supervisors were attending an upcoming meeting at Sawmill Road. Supervisors will check with Eric Stahley on particulars of meeting.
- Atty Karpowich attended meeting questioning progress of work on Paperdale. J. Kline stated that the ditch was cleaned and the situation has been inspected by PennDOT and the Conservation District and they found no problems. Resident Scatena stated the pipe is undersized. Attorney suggested using ARPA grant money to resolve problem. Supervisors and interested parties will meet at site after tar & chip is complete.
- Resident Saxton mentioned PEMA will conduct an observed exercise in October for EMA.
- Resident Blakeney was concerned with the cell tower on Oak Road. He brought documentation that it would cause health issues. He stated the tower must come down by October 1.

There being no further business for consideration, J. Beishline motion to adjourn, seconded by Scott Masich. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:47 PM.
