Minutes of June 2, 2015 Regular Meeting

Reports:

Road Foreman:

- Preparing for tar and chip to begin on June 23.
- Work on roads –berm; mow; clean up after storms on Schoolhouse, Harrison and Mountain Roads.
- COG oil bid to Hammaker – CRS2 \$1.83 and E1 Prime \$1.42. Prices lower than last year. Materials contracted. No increase for duration of contract.
- No cinders are available at Washingtonville. McClure Enterprises of Scranton can supply, but a higher cost.

- 3 bids to replace 54” pipe on Kramer Hill Road. J. Kline made motion to table until next meeting, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

New Business:

- Agricultural Security Area developed in 1996. A resident recently inquired about becoming part of the ASA. J. Challingsworth stated he was not aware this was in effect. Will need to reconvene a Board to review existing members and update their information. Will need to

advertise to offer membership to residents. Members of the Board must include a Township official, member of the general public and two to three farmers. Will be posted this month for next months' Township meeting.
