Minutes of June 4, 2019 Regular Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman J. Kline.
- May meeting minutes reviewed. E. Bogert J. Beishline motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.
- The financials were reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

Reports:

Road Foreman:

- Getting roads ready for tar & chip on Jul 8. Cold patch put down; berming. Helping Sugarloaf with a project. Prepping Mountain Road for reclamation. New backhoe working well.

Old Business:

- After contacting several computer dealers with no luck in getting a reply, Secretary stated she would rather purchase from Better Business Solutions. They have been quick to respond to problems, and are reasonable prices. J. Beishline made motion to go with BBS, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.
- Stop Road Vacation – Paperwork supplied by Resident Challingsworth dated 1931 shows vacation leaving 950 feet of active road, which is less than 2/10 mile that PennDOT shows the Township maintaining. Resident Carter asked to review this paperwork stating she has newer paperwork that is different. Discussion will continue at next meeting.

New Business:

- Co-op cost of placement of ads in newspaper with Columbia County Conservation District for bidding out work to be done on stream restoration. Cooperation of Township is needed for CCCD to apply for grant to complete work. Two properties in Fishing Creek Township will be involved. One is on Harrison and one on Winding Road. J. Beishline made motion to co-op, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.
- Motion to approve COG contract for tar & chip to be started on July 8 was made by J. Beishline, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried. Vestal's was successful bidder, with Midland second and Hammaker third.
- Wieck subdivision to combine parcels was reviewed. Supervisors had no issues with the plans. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

Correspondence:

Recognition of Guests/For the Good of the Township:

- Resident Bosak thanked Supervisors for fixing Church Road.
- Resident Blakeney asked if CCCD could allow Township to stockpile materials removed from stream restoration projects. J. Kline stated it does not make a good road surface due to sand content.

- Resident Stackhouse questioned when Sleepy Hollow would be repaired. J. Kline stated FEMA will be inspecting damage July 16 and 17. If no money forthcoming for repairs from FEMA, Township will make road passable.

There being no further business for consideration, E. Bogert made motion to adjourn, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:30 PM.
