Minutes of March 7, 2017 Regular Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman J. Challingsworth.

Reports:

Road Foreman:

- Kinney Hill Road bid ready for advertising upon review by Nancy Corbin of the Conservation District. Work will be done between July 1 and September 30. E. Bogert made motion to advertise, seconded by J. Challingsworth. Motion carried.
- Road crew has been mowing, patching, berming Mountain Road. Worked on equipment.
- Kocher spent 4 days trimming trees on Mountain Road. Will need an additional 10 hours to complete job. J. Challingsworth made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.
- Electrical work partially completed in office. Township worked with electrician to save on costs. COG inspected work done to date.
- Hauling quotes were discussed. Yost was low bidder for hauling from the locations most used by Township. (Note: Township may award hauling single hauler per State regulations.) **Hauling quotes attached to minutes. J. Kline made motion to accept Yost quote, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.
