- The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman J. Kline.
- February meeting minutes reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.
- The financials were reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

**Reports:**

**Auditors:**

- Auditors reviewed findings and made suggestions. Reports are attached. Secretary will check rates for single stream recycling with Foughts Disposal.

**Road Foreman:**

- Crew worked some dirt roads, clean ditches, patch holes, clean up downed trees, maintain trucks.
- J. Kline asked for motion to purchase 1000 ton of cinders. J. Beishline made motion, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

**SEO:**

- Gary Smith sewage module reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

**Old Business:**

- Several residents in attendance wanted more information on the proposed updated Floodplain Ordinance. Update is mandated by FEMA. E. Bogert made a motion to table until next meeting, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.
- MOU with Columbia County Resiliency Office has been put on hold for more clarification. Commissioner Ridgway and Resiliency Officer Eric Stahley will attend April meeting to discuss.
- Resident Roat stated she is still having water issues on Strawberry Lane. Pipe needs to be replaced. Neighbor has blocked pipe which is funneling water onto her property. Supervisors will inspect and discuss with solicitor.

**New Business:**

- Hauling quotes were reviewed. Yost was successful bidder with lowest quotes for Pike's Creek and Newport Aggregates. (List attached). J. Beishline made motion, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.
- Motion to approve new Permit Application forms by J. Beishline, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried. (Resolution 03-2018) Updated forms will be available online.
- Supervisors are reviewing updated Driveway and Pre-Construction Ordinances to be advertised for inspection and possibly adopted at the April meeting.

**Correspondence:**

Columbia County Commissioners have asked that a standard form be adopted for reporting construction of any kind in the Township. The form will be submitted to Tri County COG; Planning Commission; and Columbia County Tax Office each month.

**Recognition of Guests/For the Good of the Township:**

- Resident Filohoski stated a neighbor's driveway pipe is crushed and a new pipe needed to keep water from flowing back into her field. J. Kline will have Conservation District look at situation.
- Resident Sauger asked for a copy of changes to new Floodplain Ordinance and also a copy of budget. Secretary will forward.
- Resident Saxton mentioned the upcoming EMA drills for June. Volunteers are needed.
- Resident Challingsworth suggested road workers maintain a spreadsheet indication which roads have been worked on and materials used.

- Resident Blakeney recommended a list of changes to the updated Floodplain Ordinance be compiled. Resident Coates will review the documents she requested.
- Resident Stackhouse commented that roads the current Supervisors/Road Crew inherited are hard to keep in good condition due to poor maintenance in the past.
- J. Kline announced that a "Road Closed" sign, stand and two cones were stolen from Tioga Pike.
