- The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman J. Kline.
- February meeting minutes reviewed. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.
- The financials were reviewed. Additional invoice to Don's Truck Repair for broken leaf spring on 1998 Ford \$1233.10. E. Bogert made motion to approve, seconded by J. Beishline. Motion carried.

- Supervisors discussed purchase of backhoe. John Deere and CAT brought demonstrators to use during August flood. John Deere better machine. Purchase price \$116,401.50. JD will allow \$14,000 trade in value for old backhoe. Secretary will check with bank on interest rates. JD offering 4.75%. Motion to purchase John Deere 310SL backhoe by J. Beishline, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried. Delivery will take 8-9 weeks.
- COG paperwork completed for tar, chip and dust oil. Will chip 6 miles and 1 mile of dust oil. 23,000 CRS UPM oil and 3200 gallons E1 Prime.
