Minutes of October 9, 2017 Regular Meeting

-The meeting was called to order at 6 PM by Chairman Jay Challingsworth.

-September meeting minutes reviewed. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

-The financials were reviewed. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

Reports: Road Foreman:

- Box paving; mowing; cleaning ditches. Truck 551 to Sunbury Motors for alignment.

- Quotes were solicited by phone for a replacement for the Township's utility truck. Bald Eagle Twp: 2014 GMC 2500, gas, 46,000 miles, dual wheels \$35,000 - \$50,000 (no firm price set. They have not received new truck yet); Jack Metzger Ford (private owner): 2006 F450 V10, 94,000 miles, needs tires, no utility box, \$10,995; DeAngelo Auto Sales: 2012 F350 Ford 4x4, 126,000 miles, new tires, large utility box, \$17,500. After much discussion, J. Kline made motion to buy from DeAngelo, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried.

Powlus, sewage Officer, asked to have tentative approval of Hack sewage module, pending his review of location for alternate site for septic system due to the wetlands in the area. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by J. Challingsworth. Motion carried.

Old Business:

-PennDOT was contacted with regard to the improvements previously scheduled for the bridge at Winding Road, Rt 487 intersection. First response from PennDOT indicated the work was scheduled for 2024-2025. A more recent phone call from PennDOT indicated the improvements to this area would take place in May 2018. J. Kline expressed concerns regarding the amount of traffic coming on to Rt 487 from Zaners Rd, school bus routes, etc. Secretary relay these concerns.

New Business:

-Bogert subdivision was reviewed. J. Kline made motion to approve, seconded by J. Challingsworth. E. Bogert abstained.

Correspondence:

-Letter from PennDOT listing 5 locations where bridges will be repaired/replaced. List can be reviewed at Township office.

-Resident Blakeney questioned invoice from Yost for roller rental. J. Kline explained roller needed for this type of work.

-Resident Ehmman again brought the condition of neighboring property to Supervisors attention. J. Kline explained the advice the Township received from our solicitor. Township cannot be involved in a dispute between neighbors.

There being no further business for consideration, J. Kline made motion to adjourn, seconded by E. Bogert. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 PM.
