**Road Foreman:**

- Crew has been repairing flood damage. No word on assistance from FEMA. Municipal Services inspected road damages. The estimate of work still to be completed nearly \$500,000. Township finances are strained. Sleepy Hollow Road closed. Yost Excavating, Hile Enterprises were very helpful during emergency. Kee Equipment also assisted. North Centre sent crew to help. J. Kline wanted to thank North Centre publicly. Township residents helped clear roads with their own equipment. A big thank you to those residents as well. Road crew will continue to work on repairs. Kline and Beishline helped with tar & chip at North Centre.
